AB 481 requires law enforcement agencies to obtain the approval of its governing body to enact a military equipment use policy before purchasing, raising funds for, or acquiring military equipment. This policy must be passed via ordinance and renewed by a vote of the Council each year. AB 481 provides an expansive definition of "military equipment" that includes many items which law enforcement agencies use, deploy, and obtain on a regular basis. It should be noted that the Gardena Police Department is not signed up for and does not participate in the Department of Defense 10-33 Program for Law Enforcement. The law enforcement agency is required to return annually to provide an Annual Report to the governing body and the public at large. The agency is also required to host a community engagement session for members of the public to attend.

On May 24, 2022, the City Council for the City of Gardena adopted Ordinance 1841 adopting a Military Equipment Use Policy governing the law enforcement's use of items that are deemed "military equipment" under AB 481.
