

**LAWS & PRINCIPLES OF THE NEW
AQUARIUS ERA - THE PRINCIPLE OF
GOODWILL**

Humanity lives under the direction of the heavens, the stars, planets, Sun and moon. Astrology is its study, the heavens our classroom. Humanity also lives within ages (each age is 2,500 years long). Ages are determined by the Sun entering and exiting the atmosphere of one of the twelve signs. Our Sun is presently exiting the Age of Pisces and entering the atmosphere/Age of Aquarius.
