

WESAK TAURUS FESTIVAL -
BUDDHA'S APPEARANCE IN THE
HIMALAYAS

Every year (this year, May 1, 2026) at the Taurus solar festival (Scorpio full moon), a great blessing is bestowed upon humanity by the Buddha, Christ's brother.
